This afternoon the Province announced that beginning Monday, June 15th, the restriction on visitation in long-term care facilities is being relaxed. There will be stringent requirements visitors must follow.

This is very welcomed news, but we only received official notice just prior to the public announcement. Each nursing home must now review the requirements and determine how we can apply them within our unique environments. This work was underway but is not quite complete. We do know the visit must be outside, pre-scheduled and limited to two people per resident. As well, visitors will be screened and must be asymptomatic, wear a mask and strictly adhere to physical distancing.

With 149 residents and just as many (and more!) loved ones wanting to reconnect, visitation requires we have our protocols and policies established to ensure all necessary safeguards are met before we begin. We ask that you wait for the announcement on when we will start booking appointments.
