Position Summary

Qualifications

1. Must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment.
2. Must be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or a person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*, and legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.
3. Must be able to work evenings and weekends.
4. Must be musically inclined and able to play at least one musical instrument.
5. Working towards a degree in music therapy is an asset.
6. Keen interest and experience working with the elderly is an asset.

Responsibilities

1. Observe and practice all safety rules and regulations.
2. Implement one to one music with residents and group programs.
