House Updates

Increasing our Hours of Care

The government will be moving forward with the increase to 4.1 hours of care. We are currently funded for 2.45 hours of care/CCA/resident/day plus 1 hour registered staff/resident/day or 3.45 hours. The change will see CCA hours increase to 3.0/resident/day and registered staff to 1.1/resident/day. Over the next couple of months Ken, Director of Resident Care, will be working on the nursing schedules and collaborating with both unions (CUPE, NSNU) to determine how many additional positions will be required.

5th Floor Renovations

The nurse's station on the 5th floor will begin renovations at the end of October or early November. The renovations will take approximately 2 weeks to complete. The finished product will provide staff with a functionally enhanced working area, as well as a pleasant sitting area for residents.

The scope of the project will include the removal of a wall to accommodate a new workstation, new lighting, new ceiling, new flooring, and fresh new paint colours. We are very excited to have this project commence, it's a small project which will have a big impact for the 5th floor. We can't wait for the finished product!
